"Man proposes, but God disposes." This statement, a religious cliché in times past, was written by the Augustinian monk Thomas á Kempis in his classic book *On the Imitation of Christ*. An expanded, more modern version would say, "Man does what he can, God does what He will." Perhaps Solomon said it best: "There are many plans in a man's heart, nevertheless the Lord's counsel—that will stand" (Prov. 19:21, NKJV).
